DECISION

UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS ARE DENIED

The Claimant appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. The members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. The administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED**.

The Board is deciding that excessive absenteeism was proven. It has considered the absence in April for the anniversary to be excused since it was approved by the Employer. On absences where no excuse is given at the time of the absence, and none is given in the record, we find the absences to be not excused. *Higgins v. Iowa Department of Job Service*, 350 N.W.2d 187, 191 (Iowa 1984)(emphasis added) see Spragg v. Becker-Underwood, Inc. 672 N.W.2d 333, 2003 WL 22339237 (Iowa App. 2003) (refusal). Where the Employer shows that there was no excuse given at the time of the absence and

none appears in the record of the hearing then that absence or tardy is not for an excused reason. We thus have included in the list of unexcused absences those that fit these criteria. Accordingly we affirm the disqualification for excessive unexcused absenteeism.
