**STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

Iowa Workforce Development (“IWD”) issued a decision finding Appellant was not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits because IWD mailed him a notice to report for a reemployment and eligibility assessment and he failed to report. Appellant appealed.

IWD transferred the case to the Division of Administrative Hearings on January 17, 2013 to schedule a contested case hearing. A telephone hearing was scheduled for March 22, 2013 at 2:00 pm. On January 25, 2013, my office received a request for a dismissal from the IWD representatives. A new Decision, dated 01/15/13, accompanied the dismissal request. This decision reinstated the Appellant's unemployment insurance eligibility without a gap in benefits. The initial decision, dated 01/09/13, denied the Appellant's UI benefits because he failed to report for a reemployment services orientation. He later reported and participated in the required orientation, so he became eligible for benefits again. IWD restored his eligibility and paid benefits without a gap in coverage. The issues on this appeal were resolved in the Appellant's favor and are now moot. The request to dismiss the appeal is granted.

### **DECISION**

IWD's request to dismiss this appeal is granted. The information submitted shows that the issue on appeal was resolved in the Appellant's favor. This matter is deemed dismissed.
