STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a representative's June 19, 2013 determination (reference 08) that held the claimant eligible to receive benefits because she did not have a valid unemployment insurance claim when she declined the employer's April 18, 2012 offer of work. A hearing was scheduled on August 1, 2013. On July 22, 2013, the employer faxed to the Appeals Section a withdrawal request. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew an appeal from a representative's June 19, 2013 determination (reference 08). The employer faxed a withdrawal request to the Appeals Section on July 22, 2013.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to withdraw its appeal is approved.

DECISION:

The representative's June 19, 2013 determination (reference 08) is affirmed. The	employer's
withdrawal request is approved. This means that based on the employer's April 18,	2012 offer
of work, the claimant remains eligible to receive benefits as of June 2, 2013.
