STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Employer filed an appeal from a decision of a representative dated May 1, 2013, reference 02, which held claimant eligible for unemployment insurance benefits. After due notice, a hearing was scheduled for and held on June 7, 2013. Claimant participated. Employer participated by Maria Mays, Risk Administration Assistant and Sammie Teel, Recruiter. Prior to the hearing being held, appellant requested the appeal be withdrawn.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether the appeal should be withdrawn.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having considered the evidence in the record, finds that: A request has been made by the appealing party to withdraw the appeal. The request has been submitted by recorded call.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The decision of the representative dated May 1, 2013, reference 02, is affirmed. The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal is approved, and the decision of the representative shall stand and remain in full force and effect. Claimant is entitled to receive unemployment insurance benefits, provided all other eligibility requirements have been satisfied.
