## **DISSENTING OPINION OF KIM D. SCHMETT:**

I respectfully dissent from the majority decision of the Employment Appeal Board; I would reverse the administrative law judge's decision. The record supports the Claimant violated company by failing to report his arrest within 24 hours. In addition, he lied about the reason for his arrest. The Claimant admitted to using meth, which led to the Employer's requiring him to submit to a drug test in the first place. For these reasons, I would find the Employer satisfied their burden of proving disqualifying misconduct and I would deny benefits until such time he has worked in and has been paid wages for insured work equal to ten times his weekly benefit amount, provided he is otherwise eligible. See, lowa Code section 96.5(2)"a".
