STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Debby Foust filed an appeal from a decision issued by Iowa Workforce Development (the Department) dated January 8, 2014 (reference 03). In this decision, the Department determined that Foust was overpaid unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$296 for the week of May 26 through June 1, 2013 because of a failure to report wages earned with Matrix Metals LLC.

The case was transmitted from Workforce Development to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on January 28, 2014 to schedule a contested case hearing. A Notice of Telephone Hearing was mailed to all parties on January 31, 2014 scheduling a hearing for February 27, 2014 before Administrative Law Judge Laura Lockard. Prior to the hearing date, the Department issued a decision reducing the overpayment to \$0

based on information provided by the employer indicating that it reported Foust's wages to the Department in error.

The Department's decision dated February 5, 2014 reducing the Appellant's overpayment to \$0 has made the Appellant's case moot as this is the relief she sought through the appeal process.

DECISION

The Appellant's appeal is dismissed as moot. The Department has amended its decision to eliminate the overpayment that the Appellant challenged. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
