Section 96.4-3 - Able to and Available for Work

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant appealed an unemployment insurance decision dated October 5, 2004, reference 02, that concluded he was not able to and available for work. A telephone hearing was held on November 9, 2004. The parties were properly notified about the hearing. The claimant participated in the hearing. No one participated in the hearing on behalf of the employer.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The claimant's treating physician prepared a statement dated September 30, 2004, stating that the claimant was not able to perform his occupation from "April 3, 2004, to the present." Since September 30, 2004, the claimant has not been released to return to work by his doctor.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The issue in this case is whether the claimant is able to work, available for work, and earnestly and actively seeking work as defined by the unemployment insurance law in Iowa Code section 96.4-3.

The unemployment insurance rules provide that an individual who submits a medical report from a physician stating that the individual is not presently able to work is deemed unavailable for work. 871 IAC 24.23(6). In this case, the claimant's doctor has stated that he is presently unable to work. The claimant, therefore, is ineligible to receive benefits effective September 5, 2004, and continuing until he reapplies for benefits and demonstrates that he is again able to and available for work.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated October 5, 2004, reference 02, is affirmed. The claimant, therefore, is ineligible to receive benefits effective September 5, 2004, and continuing until he reapplies for benefits and demonstrates that he is again able to and available for work.
