### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a representative's April 9, 2010 decision (reference 01) that concluded the claimant was eligible to receive benefits because he was on a short-term layoff. A hearing was scheduled on May 27, 2010. Prior to the hearing, the employer withdrew its appeal in this matter. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

### FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew its appeal from the representative's April 9, 2010 decision. The Appeals Section received the employer's withdrawal request by fax on May 26, 2010.

### **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to withdraw its appeal is approved.

## **DECISION:**

The representative's April 9, 2010 decision (reference 01) is affirmed. The employer's withdrawal request is approved. The claimant remains qualified to receive unemployment insurance benefits as of February 28, 2010, provided he meets all other eligibility requirements. The employer's account may be charged.
