871 IAC 26.8(1) – Withdrawal of Appeal

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

Vernon A. Carpenter filed an appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated November 10, 2010, reference 01, that ruled he was ineligible for state unemployment insurance benefits effective October 31, 2010 upon a finding that he had not earned and been paid insured wages of at least \$250.00 since November 1, 2009. Due notice was issued for a telephone hearing to be held January 21, 2011. At the time of the hearing, the claimant requested that it be withdrawn.

**ISSUE:**

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: The claimant, the appellant in this matter, has requested that the appeal be withdrawn.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

A rule found at 871 IAC 26.8(1) allows the administrative law judge to grant an appellant's request for the withdrawal of its appeal. A review of all matters of record persuades the administrative law judge that it is appropriate to allow the withdrawal of this appeal.

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

- (1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

**DECISION:**

The unemployment insurance decision dated November 10, 2010, reference 01, remains in effect. The claimant is ineligible for state unemployment insurance benefits effective October 31, 2010.
