STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Claimant/Appellant Ethan Wisner appealed a decision issued by Respondent Iowa Workforce Development (“IWD”) dated July 24, 2013, reference 01, finding that he was ineligible for unemployment benefits.

IWD transmitted the administrative files to the Department of Inspections and Appeals for a contested case hearing that was scheduled for November 1, 2013.

On October 14, 2013, I received a communication from Shanlyn Seivert reporting that all benefits have now been paid and that there are no more issues to be resolved. She requests that the matter be dismissed.

DECISION

These appeals are dismissed because no issues remain to be resolved.
