STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Linda D. Jackson filed an appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated February 9, 2010, reference 01, that ruled she had been overpaid unemployment insurance benefits in the gross amount of \$413.00 for the week ending January 9, 2010 because of a fact-finding decision ruling that she was ineligible for benefits for that week. After due notice was issued, a telephone hearing was held June 25, 2010. This matter is considered on a consolidated record with appeal number 10A-UI-08189-AT.

ISSUES:

Has the claimant filed a timely appeal? Has the claimant been overpaid?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: In the decision in the companion case this administrative law judge has ruled that the claimant's appeal can be accepted as timely. The claimant received unemployment insurance benefits for the week ending January 9, 2010. The companion decision has ruled that she was entitled to receive them.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

For the reasons stated in the companion decision, the administrative law judge concludes that the appeal can be accepted as timely. Since the claimant was entitled to receive benefits for the week ending January 9, 2010, it necessarily follows that she has not been overpaid.

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DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated February 9, 2010, reference 01, is reversed.	The
claimant has not been overpaid for the week ending January 9, 2010.
