Section 96.3-7 – Recovery of Overpayments

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

Aaron H. Bowen filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated January 30, 2012, reference 07, that ruled he had been overpaid emergency unemployment compensation benefits in the gross amount of \$4,507.00 for the 23 weeks ending December 31, 2011. Due notice was issued for a telephone hearing to be held February 29, 2012. Mr. Bowen did not respond to the notice. This decision is based on information in agency benefit payment records and overpayment records.

**ISSUE:**

Has the claimant been overpaid?

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

Aaron H. Bowen received emergency unemployment compensation benefits totaling \$4,507.00 for the 23 weeks ending December 31, 2011. The fact-finding decision holding him ineligible for those benefits has been affirmed by administrative law judge decision 12A-EUCU-00046-AT.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

Iowa Code section 96.3-7 requires that benefits paid by the agency in error be repaid. The evidence in this record establishes both that Mr. Bowen received the benefits in question and that the fact-finding decision holding him ineligible for them has been affirmed. They must be repaid.

**DECISION:**

The unemployment insurance decision dated January 30, 2012, reference 07, is affirmed. The claimant has been overpaid \$4,507.00 in emergency unemployment compensation benefits for the 23 weeks ending December 31, 2011.
