STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Iowa Workforce Development ("IWD") issued a decision finding Appellant was not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits because he failed to attend a reemployment services workshop. Appellant appealed.

An appeal hearing was held on November 17, 2011. Appellant Mark McCool appeared. William Myers appeared on behalf of IWD. Exhibits 1 through 3 were admitted into the

record. At the start of the hearing McCool stated he wanted to withdraw his appeal. IWD's rules allow an appellant to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision, with the approval of the administrative law judge.¹ The request to withdraw the appeal is granted.

DECISION

Appellant's request to withdraw the appeal is granted. This matter is deemed withdrawn.
