STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a representative's December 11, 2009 decision (reference 01) that concluded the claimant was qualified to receive benefits, and the employer's account was subject to charge because the claimant voluntarily quit her employment for reasons that qualify her to receive benefits. A hearing was scheduled on February 1, 2010. Prior to the scheduled hearing, the employer withdrew its appeal. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew its appeal from a representative's December 11, 2009 decision. The employer's withdrawal was faxed to the Appeals Section on January 14, 2010.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to withdraw its appeal is approved.

DECISION:

The representative's December 11, 2009 decision (reference 01) is affirmed. The employer's withdrawal request is approved. The claimant remains qualified to receive unemployment insurance benefits as of November 22, 2009, provided she meets all other eligibility requirements. The employer's account may be charged for benefits paid to the claimant.
