## DECISION

The Employer appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. The members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. The administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED**.

The Employment Appeal Board would remand this matter to the Iowa Workforce Development Center, Claims Section, for consideration of what bearing the Claimant's workers' compensation temporary disability payments have on her unemployment compensation claim.

871 IAC 24.13(3)"d" provides:

*Fully deductible payments from benefits.* The following payments are considered as wages; however, such payments are fully deductible from benefits on a dollar-for-dollar basis:

Workers' compensation, temporary disability only. The payment shall be fully deductible with respect to the week in which the individual is entitled to the workers'' compensation for temporary disability, and not to the week in which such payment is paid.
