STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Sara Terry filed an appeal from a decision issued by Iowa Workforce Development (IWD) dated August 12, 2016 (reference 02). In this decision, IWD determined that Terry was ineligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits effective August 7, 2016 because she failed to report for a reemployment and eligibility assessment.

The case was transmitted from IWD to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on September 14, 2016 and a hearing was scheduled for October 17, 2016. Prior to the hearing, the Department issued a decision dated September 15, 2016 reinstating Terry's eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits effective August 7, 2016, provided she meets the other eligibility requirements.

The Department's most recent action has made the Appellant's case moot as the decision she appealed has been reversed.

DECISION

The Appellant's appeal is dismissed as moot. The Department has amended its decision to reverse the disqualification imposed by its August 12, 2016 decision.

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
