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## STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Alexander Peter filed an appeal from a decision issued by Iowa Workforce Development (the Department) dated March 10, 2015 (reference 02). In this decision, the Department determined that Alexander was ineligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits effective March 1, 2015 because he failed to participate in a reemployment and eligibility assessment on March 1, 2015..

The case was transmitted from Workforce Development to the Department of Inspections and Appeals and a hearing was scheduled for April 13, 2015. Prior to the hearing date, the Department provided information indicating that it had reversed its decision disqualifying Peter and had had restored Peter's eligibility for benefits without any loss to him.

The Department's most recent action has made the Appellant's case moot as the decision he appealed has been reversed.

**DECISION**

The Appellant's appeal is dismissed as moot. The Department has amended its decision to reverse the disqualification imposed by its March 10, 2015 decision. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
