STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a representative's May 20, 2011 determination (reference 01) that held the claimant qualified to receive benefits and the employer's account subject to charge because the claimant had been discharged for nondisqualifying reasons. A hearing was scheduled on June 23, 2011. On June 13, 2011, the employer made a request to withdraw the appeal. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew its appeal from the representative's May 20, 2011 determination. The employer's withdrawal request was faxed to the Appeals Section on June 13, 2011.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to withdraw its appeal is approved.

DECISION:

The representative's May 20, 2011 determination (reference 01) is affirmed. The employer's request to withdraw the appeal in this matter is approved. This means the claimant remains qualified to receive benefits as of April 24, 2011, provides she meets all other elitigility requirements. The employer's account is subject to charge.
