NOTICE

THIS DECISION BECOMES FINAL unless (1) a **request for a REHEARING** is filed with the Employment Appeal Board within **20 days** of the date of the Board's decision or, (2) a **PETITION TO DISTRICT COURT IS FILED WITHIN 30 days** of the date of the Board's decision.

A **REHEARING REQUEST** shall state the specific grounds and relief sought. If the rehearing request is denied, a petition may be filed in **DISTRICT COURT** within **30 days** of the date of the denial.

DECISION

The Claimant appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. Two members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds it cannot affirm the administrative law judge's decision. The Employment Appeal Board **REVERSES** as set forth below.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Administrative Law Judge's Findings of Fact are adopted by the Board as its own.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

We have today allowed regular benefits, based on requalifying wages, over the same period of time of this overpayment. As a result, the Claimant is not overpaid FPUC benefits.

DECISION:

The administrative law judge's decision dated May 19, 2022 is **REVERSED**. The Employment Appeal Board concludes that the Claimant was not overpaid any FPUC benefits.
