STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a representative's November 9, 2011 determination (reference 01) that held the claimant eligible to receive benefits and the employer's account subject to charge because he had been discharged for nondisqualifying reasons. A hearing was scheduled on December 13, 2011. On December 8, the employer made a request to withdraw the appeal in this matter. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew its appeal from the representative's November 9, 2011 determination. The employer's representative faxed a withdrawal request on December 8, 2011.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to withdraw its appeal is approved.

DECISION:

The representative's November 9, 2011 determination (reference 01) is affirmed. The employer's withdrawal request is approved. This means the claimant remains qualified to receive benefits, provided he meets all other eligibility requirements.
