STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Claimant/appellant filed an appeal from the August 28, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits.

A telephone hearing was held on October 27, 2020. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. Claimant participated personally. Employer participated through Nathen Olson. Appellant withdrew her appeal on the record.

ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The appellant requested to withdraw the appeal on the record during the hearing on October 27, 2020.

The administrative law judge notes this decision does not impact the decision finding claimant eligible for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA). If claimant has questions regarding that decision or wishes to appeal it, she should review that decision and proceed accordingly.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id.*

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the August 28, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
