**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

An appeal was filed from a representative's decision dated August 27, 2014, reference 01. A hearing was scheduled for September 25, 2014. Prior to the hearing being held, appellant requested the appeal be withdrawn.

**ISSUE:**

The issue is whether the appeal should be withdrawn.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

The administrative law judge, having considered the evidence in the record, finds that: A request has been made by the appealing party to withdraw the appeal. The request has been submitted by verbal request over the phone when the administrative law judge called for the appeal hearing.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

**DECISION:**

The decision of the representative dated August 27, 2014, reference 01, is affirmed. The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal is approved and the decision of the representative shall stand and remain in full force and effect. Claimant is not entitled to receive unemployment insurance benefits in regards to this employer, until eligibility requirements have been satisfied.
