### **STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

The claimant filed an appeal of a representative's decision dated July 27, 2014, reference 05. A Notice was mailed to all parties on October 30, 2014 setting a hearing date of November 24, 2014 at 8:00 a.m. The notice contained instructions regarding how to participate in the telephone hearing. Neither the appellant nor any representative from Iowa Workforce Development (the Department) called in to participate in the hearing at the date and time indicated.

The Iowa Administrative Procedure Act provides that if a party fails to appear or participate in a contested case proceeding after proper service of notice, the presiding

officer may enter a default decision.<sup>1</sup> Iowa Workforce Development regulations give the presiding officer discretion regarding whether to proceed with a hearing in the absence of one or more of the parties.<sup>2</sup> In this case, a hearing was not held and a default decision was entered against the appellant.

### **DECISION**

The appellant's appeal is dismissed. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
