STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed an appeal from the July 12, 2013, (reference 04) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits. Due to subsequent agency action no hearing was held.

ISSUE:

Did the claimant fail to report as directed?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: The representative's decision the claimant appealed from dated July 12, 2013, reference 04 ,denied benefits effective July 7, 2013. In a representative's decision dated July 18, 2013, reference 05, amending reference 04, the agency reversed that denial and allowed benefits effective July 7, 2013. It was found that the claimant did not fail to report as directed.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Inasmuch as the agency reversed the prior ineligibility decision prior to the hearing, there is no issue for the administrative law judge to adjudicate.

The claimant did not fail to report as directed.

DECISION:

The representative's decision dated July 12, 2013, reference 04, is reversed so as to be consistent with the subsequent agency action. Benefits are allowed, provided the claimant is otherwise eligible.
