871 IAC 26.8(1) - Withdrawal of Appeal

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

College Community School District (employer) appealed a representative's June 8, 2007 decision (reference 01) that concluded Anne C. Cook (claimant) was qualified to receive unemployment insurance benefits, and the employer's account was subject to charge because the claimant had been discharged for nondisqualifying reasons. Prior to a hearing being held, the employer submitted a written request to withdraw its appeal. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

ISSUE:

At issue in this matter is whether the appellant herein should be allowed to withdraw its appeal.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew its appeal from the June 8, 2007 decision. The employer's written withdrawal request was received by the Appeals Section on July 31, 2007.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to withdraw its appeal is approved.

DECISION:

The representative's June 8, 2007 decision (reference 01) is affirmed. The employer's withdrawal request is approved. The claimant remains qualified to receive unemployment insurance benefits as of May 20, 2007, provided she meets all other eligibility requirements. The employer's account may be charged for benefits paid to the claimant.
