STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Edward Poggenpohl filed an appeal from two decisions issued by Iowa Workforce Development (the Department). In a decision dated June 14, 2013, reference 01, the Department determined that Mr. Poggenpohl was ineligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits effective June 9, 2013 because he failed to report for an appointment with the Department. The second decision, dated June 18, 2013, reference 02, the Department determined that Mr. Poggenpohl had been overpaid unemployment benefits.

The cases were transmitted from Workforce Development to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on June 27, 2013 to schedule a contested case hearing. A Notice of Hearing was issued to all parties on July 5, 2013 scheduling a hearing date of August 2, 2013. Prior to the hearing date, the Department provided a written withdrawal of his appeals from Mr. Poggenpohl.

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The Appellant's appeals are dismissed. The hearing is cancelled. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
