Section 96.4-3 - Able to and Available for Work

## STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant appealed an unemployment insurance decision dated August 25, 2005, reference 06, that concluded he was not able and available to work. A telephone hearing was held on September 15, 2004. The claimant participated in the hearing. Leigh Bell and Carrie Buckley participated on behalf of the employer. Exhibit A was admitted into evidence at the hearing.

# FINDINGS OF FACT:

The claimant worked for the United States Postal Services from December 1988 to June 9, 2005. The claimant filed a new claim for unemployment insurance benefits with an effective date of June 13, 2005. His base period was from January 1, 2004, to December 31, 2004. Up

until November 2004, the claimant was working full time as a letter carrier for the United States Postal Service. In November 2004, the claimant had surgery on his knee, and after he returned to work he was unable to work full time due to restrictions on his ability to stand and walk.

At least as of August 7, 2005, the claimant has been seeking part-time work of no more than 25 hours per week because of his medical restrictions. The claimant has been determined disabled due his medical problems under the Social Security Disability program.

# REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

For an individual to be eligible to receive benefits, he must be able to work, available for work, and actively seeking work as required by the unemployment insurance law. Iowa Code section 96.4-3. The claimant has the burden to show he is able to work, available for work, and earnestly and actively seeking work. The unemployment insurance rules require that an individual be physically and mentally able to work in some full time gainful employment, not necessarily in the individual's customary occupation, but a job that is engaged in by others as a means of livelihood. 871 IAC 24.22(1).

The rules provide that a claimant must be able to work to the same degree and to the same extent as when his wages credits were earned. 871 IAC 24.22(2)(f). Since the claimant was only willing and able to work 25 hours per week or less and the wage credits were earned in full-time work, he is not considered available to work under the unemployment insurance law.

## **DECISION:**

The unemployment insurance decision dated August 25, 2005, reference 06, is affirmed. The claimant is not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits effective August 7, 2005. This disqualification will remain in effect until the claimant reapplies for benefits and establishes that he is seeking and is available for full time work.
