PL 110-252 – Emergency Unemployment Compensation

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed an appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated November 23, 2011, reference 02, that ruled he was ineligible for emergency unemployment compensation beginning June 5, 2011 because he was eligible for state unemployment insurance benefits as of that date. After due notice was issued, a telephone hearing was held December 23, 2011 with the claimant participating. The administrative law judge takes official notice of Agency benefit payment records and overpayment records.

ISSUE:

Is the claimant eligible for emergency unemployment compensation as of June 5, 2011?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Cyprian O. Ihedilionye filed a claim for unemployment insurance benefits effective June 6, 2010. The benefit year expired June 5, 2011. The claimant was monetarily eligible for a new state unemployment insurance claim as of June 5, 2011.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Public Law 110-252 establishes the eligibility requirements for the federal emergency unemployment program. A person is ineligible for the federal benefits for any week that the individual is monetarily eligible for regular state unemployment insurance benefits. An individual cannot receive both types of benefits for the same week. Since the claimant was monetarily eligible for state benefits effective June 5, 2011, he cannot receive the federal benefits as of that date.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated November 23, 2011, reference 02, is affirmed.
The claimant is ineligible for emergency unemployment compensation effective June 5, 2011.
