DECISION

UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS ARE ALLOWED IF OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE

The Employer appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. Two members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. The administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED**.

The Board has considered the allegations of bias raised by the Employer and finds they do not have merit. In this case in particular, we do not detect bias by the Administrative Law Judge. Further, this Administrative Law Judge's decisions regularly come before the Board and we have not found the Administrative Law Judge to be anything but even handed and fair. Finally, "[j]udicial predilection or an attitude of mind resulting from the facts learned by the judge from the judge's participation in the case is not a disqualifying factor." *State v. Millsap*, 704 N.W.2d 426 (Iowa 2005).

The Claimant has requested this matter be remanded for a new hearing. The Employment Appeal Board finds the applicant did not provide good cause to remand this matter. Therefore, the remand request is **DENIED**.
