STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Appellant Aaron Hagedorn filed an appeal of two decisions issued by Iowa Workforce Development dated October 21, 2016 (reference 07) and October 31, 2016 (reference 09). A Notice of Telephone Hearing was mailed to all parties on November 23, 2016 setting a hearing date of December 16, 2016 at 2:00 PM. The notice contained instructions regarding how to participate in the telephone hearing. The Appellant did not call in to participate in the hearing at the date and time indicated.

The Iowa Administrative Procedure Act provides that if a party fails to appear or participate in a contested case proceeding after proper service of notice, the presiding officer may enter a default decision.¹ Iowa Workforce Development regulations give the presiding officer discretion regarding whether to proceed with a hearing in the absence of the appealing party.² In this case, a hearing was not held and a default decision was entered.

DECISION

The Appellant's appeal is dismissed. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
