STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Employer filed an appeal from a decision of a representative dated August 5, 2011, reference 02, which held claimant eligible for unemployment insurance benefits. After due notice, a telephone conference hearing was scheduled for and held on August 31, 2011. Claimant participated personally. Employer participated by Katie Wolff, Staffing Specialist. Exhibits One, Two and A were admitted into evidence.

ISSUE:

The issue in this matter is whether the claim was previously adjudicated.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having heard the testimony and considered all of the evidence in the record, finds: Claimant last worked for employer on May 17, 2011.

Claimant was removed from assignment on May 17, 2011 by employer because he missed a day of work without calling in.

This matter was adjudicated in a decision dated June 29, 2011.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 24.28(6) provides:

Voluntary quit requalifications and previously adjudicated voluntary quit issues.

(6) The claimant voluntarily left employment. However, there shall be no disqualification under lowa Code § 96.5(1) if a decision on this same separation has been made on a prior claim by a representative of the department and such decision has become final.

In this matter, the evidence has established that the claim was previously adjudicated by decision of June 29, 2011 reference 05. The bureau is without authority to rehear this matter as a decision was issued on the merits and is final. The issue cannot be adjudicated a second time.

DECISION:

The decision of the representative dated August 5, 2011, reference 02, is affirmed.	Claimant is
eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits, provided claimant meets all otl	her eligibility
requirements.
