### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Debbie Thies (claimant/appellant) filed an appeal from the October 21, 2020 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits as of May 10, 2020 based on a finding claimant was still employed for the same hours and wages.

A telephone hearing was held on October 27, 2021. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. Claimant participated personally. Employer participated by HR Specialist Nick Reierson. Appellant withdrew her appeal on the record.

#### ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

### FINDINGS OF FACT:

The appellant requested to withdraw the appeal on the record during the hearing on October 27, 2021.

# **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. lowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id*.

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

# **DECISION:**

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the October 21, 2020 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits as of May 10, 2020 based on a finding claimant was still employed for the same hours and wages is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
