**STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

Iowa Workforce Development (“IWD”) issued a decision dated January 2, 2013, reference 03, finding Appellant Traci Speidel Pflughaupt was ineligible to receive unemployment benefits and denying benefits as of December 16, 2012. Pflughaupt filed this appeal.

On January 18, 2013, IWD issued a decision stating that the decision being appealed was issued in error and declaring the same null and void.

On February 19, 2013, I received a letter from Appellant's counsel withdrawing the appeal on behalf of his client. IWD's rules allow an appellant to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision, with the approval of the administrative law judge.<sup>1</sup> The request to withdraw the appeal is granted.

### **DECISION**

Appellant's request to withdraw this appeal is granted. The appeal is deemed withdrawn.
