STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Claimant filed an appeal from August 19, 2021 (reference 04) unemployment insurance decision that found claimant had been overpaid Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC) benefits. Claimant was properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on October 20, 2021. Claimant participated. Appellant withdrew her appeal on the record.

ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The appellant requested to withdraw the appeal on the record during the hearing on October 20, 2021.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. lowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id.*

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the August 19, 2021 (reference 04) unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
