**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

Claimant appealed a representative's decision dated February 22, 2011, reference 01, that concluded claimant was not eligible for benefits. A telephone hearing was scheduled to held on March 29, 2011 pursuant to due notice. Claimant did not participate.

**ISSUE:**

The issue is whether claimant is ineligible for emergency unemployment compensation benefits because she was eligible for regular compensation benefits.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

The administrative law judge, having considered all of the evidence in the record, finds that: The claimant was eligible for regular compensation benefits for the 40 weeks ending January 15, 2011 on her regular claim.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

Public Law 110-252, Section 4001(d)(2)(A) provides, in pertinent part:

An individual shall not be eligible for temporary extended unemployment compensation under this title unless, in the base period with respect to which the individual exhausted all rights to regular compensation under the State law, the individual had 20 weeks of full-time insured employment or the equivalent in insured wages, as determined under the provisions of the State law.

The claimant was eligible for regular compensation benefits; thus, the claimant is not eligible for emergency unemployment compensation for the 40 weeks ending January 15, 2011.

**DECISION:**

The decision of the representative dated February 22, 2011, reference 01, is affirmed. Claimant is not eligible for emergency unemployment compensation for the 40 weeks ending January 15, 2011.
