Section 96.4-4 – Eligibility for State Unemployment Insurance Benefits

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Lawrence W. Hingst filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated June 30, 2010, reference 01, that advised that he was not eligible for state unemployment insurance benefits effective June 13, 2010 upon a finding that he had not earned and been paid wages covered by the insurance system in the amount of at least \$250.00 since the beginning of his benefit year on June 14, 2009. Due notice was issued for a telephone hearing to be held August 28, 2010. Mr. Hingst did not provide a telephone number at which he could be contacted. This decision is based on information in Agency benefit payment records and wage records.

ISSUE:

Is the claimant eligible for state unemployment insurance benefits at this time?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: Lawrence W. Hingst received state unemployment insurance benefits during a benefit year beginning June 14, 2009. He has not worked since that time. He is currently receiving federal emergency unemployment compensation benefits based on his 2009 claim.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The question before the administrative law judge is limited to whether the claimant is eligible for state unemployment insurance benefits at this time. He is not. While Mr. Hingst meets the normal monetary eligibility requirements of the statute, the statute also imposes an additional requirement on individuals who have received state benefits in a prior year. The individual must also have earned and been paid covered wages of at least \$250.00 since the beginning of the last benefit year in which benefits were paid. Mr. Hingst does not meet that requirement. Therefore, he is not eligible for state unemployment insurance benefits at this time. The administrative law judge notes that Mr. Hingst is receiving federal emergency unemployment

compensation benefits based on his 2009 state claim. This decision does not affect those benefits.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated June 30, 2010, reference 01, is affirmed. The claimant is not eligible for state unemployment insurance benefits at this time. He remains eligible for federal emergency unemployment compensation.
