DECISION

UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS ARE DENIED

The Claimant appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. The members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. The administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED**.

The facts in this case strongly indicated that the Claimant should get PUA benefits. It does appear at this time that the Claimant has been approved for PUA, and an offset applied. If this is not the case, and if the Claimant has not yet applied for PUA benefits the Claimant should either apply for rehearing of our decision and explain this, **or** follow the directions for applying for PUA found at the end of the Administrative Law Judge's decision.

If the Claimant has already been approved for PUA then he need not take either of these steps.

If the Claimant has **not** already applied for PUA then **within 20 days of this decision** the Claimant may choose to do **either** of the following:

- Apply for rehearing from our decision explaining his PUA status by going to eab.iowa.gov
- Apply for PUA by following the directions at the end of the Administrative Law Judge's decision.
