STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated February 27, 2007, reference 02, that denied benefits to her. Before a final hearing could be scheduled in the matter, the claimant requests that the appeal be withdrawn.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: The claimant, the appellant in this matter, has requested that the appeal be withdrawn.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

A rule found at 871 IAC 26.8(1) allows the administrative law judge to grant an appellant's request for the withdrawal of its appeal. A review of all matters of record persuades the administrative law judge that it is appropriate to allow the withdrawal of this appeal.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated February 27, 2007, reference 02, remains in effect. Benefits are withheld until the claimant has worked in and has been paid wages for insured work equal to ten times her weekly benefit amount, provided she is otherwise eligible.
