STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer filed an appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated November 20, 2018, reference 03. On November 28, 2018, before a hearing was scheduled, the employer/appellant submitted a written withdrawal of its appeal. No hearing was scheduled or held.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The unemployment insurance decision issued on November 20, 2018, reference 03, determined that the claimant was eligible for benefits. The employer appealed this decision on November 27, 2018. On November 28, 2018, the employer, the appealing party, requested to withdraw the appeal, in writing, via fax.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw his or her appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1).

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw its appeal of the unemployment insurance decision dated November 20, 2018, reference 03, is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
