# STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Employer filed an appeal from a decision of a representative dated July 5, 2011, reference 01, which held claimant eligible for unemployment insurance benefits. After due notice, a telephone conference hearing was scheduled for and held on August 3, 2011. Claimant participated. Employer participated by Jeanne Garner. Exhibit 1 was admitted into evidence.

### **ISSUES:**

The issues in this matter are whether the claimant quit for good cause attributable to the employer and whether claimant is overpaid unemployment insurance benefits.

### FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having heard the testimony and having considered all of the evidence in the record, finds: Claimant last worked for employer on May 25, 2011. The claimant quit on May 27, 2011 because, while she was sick, she was told to find replacements for herself and she was unable to attend a funeral of a close friend for the same reason.

### **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

The administrative law judge holds that the evidence has established that claimant voluntarily quit for good cause attributable to the employer when claimant terminated the employment relationship because of detrimental conditions.

Iowa Code section 96.5-1 provides:

An individual shall be disqualified for benefits:

1. Voluntary quitting. If the individual has left work voluntarily without good cause attributable to the individual's employer, if so found by the department.

# **DECISION:**

The decision of the representative dated July 5, 2011, reference 01, is affirmed. Unemployment insurance benefits are allowed, provided claimant is otherwise eligible.
