STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed from a monetary record dated February 6, 2019. A hearing was scheduled for March 7, 2019. Prior to the hearing being held, the appellant requested the appeal be withdrawn as the agency corrected his monetary record on or about March 5, 2019 granting him the maximum amount of benefits on his claim.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge finds that: A request has been made by the appealing party to withdraw the appeal. The request has been submitted verbally and has been recorded.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal of the monetary record dated February 6, 2019 is approved.
