871 IAC 26.8(1) - Withdrawal of Appeal

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a representative's July 14, 2014 determination (reference 01) that held the claimant qualified to receive benefits and the employer's account subject to charge because the claimant had been discharged for nondisqualifying reasons. The employer requested an in-person hearing. Before the in-person hearing was scheduled, the employer sent the Appeals Bureau a withdrawal request. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew its appeal from a representative's July 14, 2014 determination (reference 01). The employer's written November 14, 2014 withdrawal request was e-mailed to the Appeals Bureau.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

- (1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's written November 14, 2014 request to withdraw this appeal is approved.

DECISION:

The representative's July 14, 2014 determination (reference 01) is affirmed. The employer's withdrawal request is approved. This means as of June 22, 2014, the claimant remains qualified to receive benefits, provided he meets all other eligibility requirements. The employer's account is subject to charge.
